The seating, including Fixture Furniture's best selling Bola, Jazz, Emotion, and Allure chairs and the classic D Chair, received the GREENGUARD Certification after meeting the stringent GREENGUARD Standards for Low Emitting Products. All GREENGUARD Certified furnishings and materials are tested on a regular basis to ensure continued low emitting status.

Fixtures Furniture Seating has applications for healthcare, education, and commercial facilities. Sustainable building programs for all three facility types reference GREENGUARD Certified furniture and furnishings as a key to better indoor air quality. The Green Guide for Healthcare positions GREENGUARD Certification as a requirement for several types of low emitting products. Numerous school building programs like the Washington Sustainable Schools' Protocol for High Performance School Facilities site GREENGUARD as a resource for low emitting products. In the U.S. Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design for Commercial Interiors (LEED-CI) Program, GREENGUARD tested and certified seating and system furniture is a referenced requirement under Credit 4.5 in the Indoor Environmental Quality section.
