Warm, organic, molded plywood seats and backs flow around a crisp, angular steel frame. This contrast of elements produces a tension that defines Morphix as a clean, uncomplicated emblem of the brand.

This is the first chair to come from the atelier of Matt Duncan, a California-based industrial designer with wide experience in the design of medical devices, where form, function and ergonomics play equal roles. Morphix is a compound name that implies an object of change and transformation. In this respect, Morphix reflects perfectly the evolution of the 60-year old Fixtures Furniture brand, from workhorse supplier of sturdy institutional chairs, to a diverse producer of affordable, design-driven seating and tables.

Available in six wood stains and 10 frame finishes, including bright chrome, Morphix also features an optional upholstered seat, available in textiles from Sina Pearson, Knoll Textiles, Momentum, Mayer Fabrics and a wide selection of approved COM. The armed version features a matching wood armcap. The armless version will stack eight high. List pricing starts at \$450.
